### **Kaposi's Sarcoma of the Foot: A Case Presentation**

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Kaposi's sarcoma has been described for many years as a rare type of endothelial neoplasm. The disease distribution predominantly appeared in areas of eastern Europe, equatorial Africa, Italy, Russia, and North America, affecting mostly elderly males. Now, practitioners have been encountering this disease in young males worldwide as a manifestation of the acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS) epidemic.
