## Weiss Memorial Hospital: Community Impact in 2021

- Created a premier Orthopedics Program with renovation of the inpatient unit, recruitment of three highly-trained surgeons and acquisition of state-of-the-art robotic technology.
- Chicago Center for Orthopedics became the official healthcare provider of professional soccer team Chicago House AC and also became the official healthcare provider for the athletic teams of Chicago State University.
- **Expanded Outpatient Behavioral Health** Program opened in 2020, with service provided through telehealth and in person.
- Recruited physician group specializing in Pain Management to add important expertise to our clinical services.
- Relocated our renowned Gender Confirmation Program physician office to the Weiss hospital campus, offering expanded services in an attractive setting.

- Provided COVID-19 vaccinations to more than 10,000 local residents through our Community Vaccination Clinic.
